As a parting note — if you see a bear in the woods, best leave it well alone, chances are it would not be as friendly as our bear!

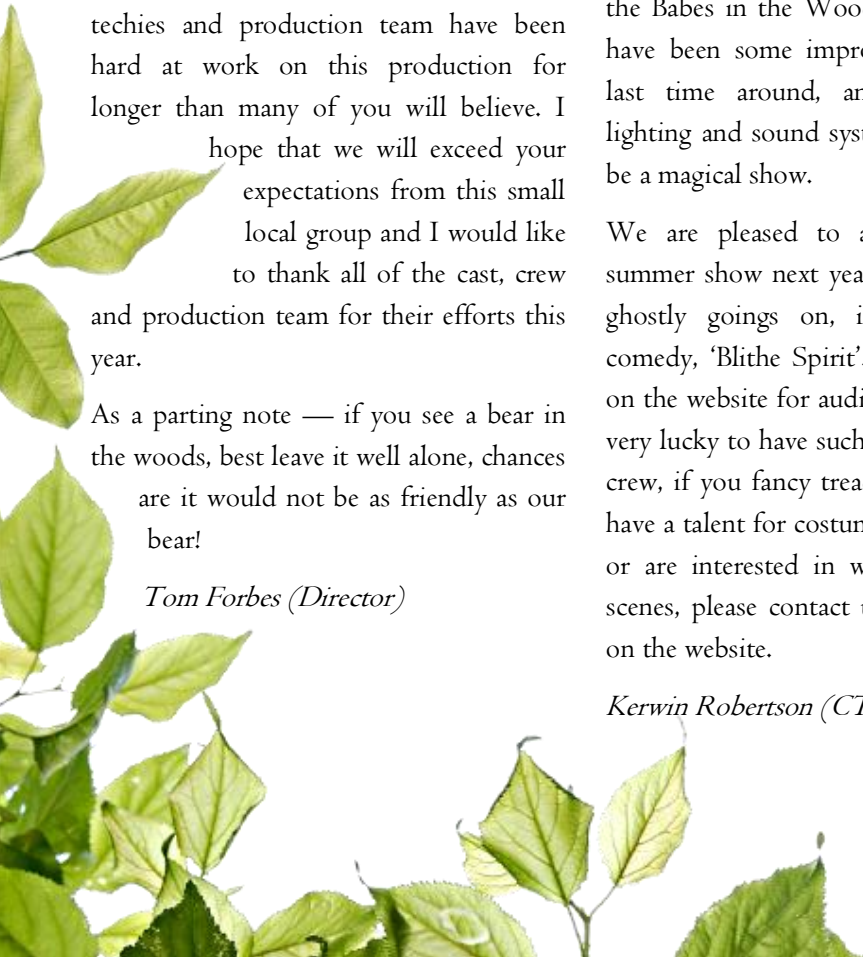
